

Tips on booking accommodation in Hong Kong

Conference venue

This year's ISOQOL meeting will take place at the Hong Kong Academy of Medicine. HKAM is located at a scenic greenery area in the Wang Chuk Hang district on the southern side of the Hong Kong Island. There is no hotel located nearby. However, you can get there from the city center of the Causeway Bay through the Aberdeen tunnel in about 10 to 15 minutes. We will arrange shuttle buses to run between our two conferences hotels and the HKAM at the beginning and the end of the conference days.

Conference hotels

You may reserve hotel room in either one of the two conference hotels, the Park Lane Hotel and the Excelsior Hotel. You may download the respective reservation forms for our conference at <http://www.isoqol.org/parklaneform2.pdf> and <http://www.isoqol.org/excelsiorbookingform.pdf>. Both hotels are equally good. You may ask for a room with park view facing the Victoria Park at the Park Lane Hotel and a harbour view room facing the Victoria harbour in the Excelsior Hotel. (You may have to pay a bit more for rooms with good views!)

Nearby hotels

If you would like to consider a hotel with lower room rate, i.e. US\$60-80 per night (2 beds for 2 persons), you have many choices. You may reserve your hotel room through your travel agent. Very often you can get discounted room rate when you book hotel room with your air-ticket. You may also book rooms through various online hotel-booking website (expedia.com, travelocity.com, hotels.com). All hotels located in Causeway district are within walking distance from the two conference hotels, where you can take the shuttle bus to the conference venue. If you prefer a hotel further away, you can select hotel located at North Point, Wanchai, and Central. You can take our underground railway (we call it MTR) from your hotel to Causeway Bay in 5 to 10 minutes. Please see MTR stations map below. (Causeway Bay station is underlined with thick red line.) Please be aware that October and November are convention seasons in Hong Kong and are very busy. You should reserve your room early to ensure you have some choices.
