

Bean Bag Toss Game Rules

Rules for Players:

Teams consist of 2 players.

Each team gets 4 bean bags to throw per round. One player from each team throws per round.

Each player throws from behind the front of the boxes. This is the foul line. The player must not pass the foul line or the player's throw does not count, and the bag is removed from play.

Partners stand directly across from one another and compete against their opponent. Whichever team scores the most points in one round is the first team to throw in the next round.

Scoring is as follows:

There are three ways to score:

IN: A bean bag that goes into the hole of the platform earns the team three points. It does not matter whether the bag goes in on the toss or if it lands on the platform and then, perhaps by wind or by being nudged by another tossed bean bag, subsequently goes in.

ON: A bag that lands anywhere on the platform and remains after all bags are thrown is worth one point -- however, no part of the bag may touch the ground. If a bag touches the ground at any point, either during the toss or after it lands, it must be removed from the platform before play continues.

DONATIONS: Each team earns 1 point for every \$100 USD donated in their name. Donation points are not added to the score until a team reaches 21 points in game.

A bag that is tossed in play and knocks another bag off or in the hole is legal.

Bags moved off the board by another thrown bag can no longer be considered for points.

Winning

- One player or team must get at least 21 points to win. In the event of a tie at 21 points (or more) at the end of a round, the winner will be determined by who raised the most donations.
