PEDESTRIAN MALL

Stephen Avenue pedestrian walkway is just outside the conference hotel, an area abundant with shopping and restaurants. **Bonus:** Alberta is Canada's only province without a provincial sales tax!



+15 SKYWALK

Calgary's downtown is equipped with a system of indoor paths 15 feet above the street that connect office buildings to shopping and restaurants, and make everything accessible in any weather condition.



TRANSIT

City bus services and the C-Train provide efficient transportation through the city. Outside the conference hotel, along 7th Avenue, is the **Free Fare Zone** where it is free for passengers to ride the C-Train and explore downtown.

CALGARY + QOL

Calgary is among the **top 5 most livable cities on earth** and is ranked among the **top cities in quality of life**.



BANFF NATIONAL PARK

Find Canada's oldest national park just 60 miles east of Calgary. You'll find three other UNESCO World Heritage Sites within 90 minutes of the city: Waterton Glacier International Peace Park, Dinosaur Provincial Park and Head-Smashed-In Buffalo Jump.



ABUNDANT SUNSHINE

Annually Calgary enjoys 333 days of sunshine, on average. It's the sunniest major city in Canada – experiencing some 2,400 hours a year of sunlight, giving way to radiant blue skies most days.

Calgary is the fastest growing big city in Canada due to natural increase, immigration and domestic migration.

Calgary has the largest commitment to green power in North America, making it one of the cleanest cities in the world.



1988 OLYMPICS
